INFORMATION ON SPECIAL EFFECTS COURSE, 1ST LEVEL Academic Year 2010

TUITION FEES

- a) The cost of the course is € 1,000.00 + IVA.
- b) To be paid at the time of enrolment.

BOOKS AND TEACHING MATERIALS

- a) The course does not require the purchase of textbooks. Various books will be presented during class and can be bought by the trainees at their discretion.
- b) The trainees must provide themselves with personal equipment: brushes, pincers, scissors, etc.
- c) The trainees will bring their own make-up products. For those trainees who do not have them, the school will see that they are supplied with them for practice at school.
- d) To obtain a good result in the course, trainees will frequently have to practise making up at home. Photography will be allowed during the lessons.

SUBJECTS/MODELS AND PHOTOGRAPHIC SERVICES

- a) **Every pupil must bring a model/subject for every lesson.**
- b) For the realization of photo services, trainees are advised to bring a model/friend from outside.
- c) The photo services will be carried out by a professional photographer. The photographs taken are not included in the course fee.
- d) Both trainees and eventual models will be requested to sign a releasing form allowing the school to use the pictures.

ATTENDANCE AND CATCH-UP LESSONS

- a) Attendance at the lessons is obligatory. If the trainee's absences exceed 10% of the lessons, the directors of the school may reserve the right not to issue the certificate of participation.
- b) The school organizes catch-up or supporting lessons for those who miss classes for serious reasons or for those who, though always present, need extra help.

FINAL EXAMINATIONS AND ISSUE OF PRIVATE CERTIFICATE

- a) No examination is foreseen.
- b) The school will issue a certificate of participation.
- c) At the end of the course trainees will fill in a questionnaire on the result achieved and the quality of the course taken.

CALENDAR AND CLASS SCHEDULE

- a) The course will be held in the first week of every month.
- b) The lessons will be from Tuesday to Saturday, from 10.00 to 14.00 or from 15.00 to 19.00

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS
